"Pay It Forward" Project

Accounting is all about "paying" and "receiving" through the recording of daily business transactions. In the holiday season, we need to remember simple messages of gracious "PAYING" and "RECEIVING".

As you will see in the movie "PAY IT FORWARD", it is also a rewarding practice to remember that when someone does something nice for you, you should "pay it forward" by doing something nice for someone else.

Class Assignment:

1. In the next few class periods, we will be watching the movies "Pay It Forward".
2. As you watch, you are being asked to complete three tasks. Task 1 will be due at the conclusion of the movie. Task 2 and 3 will be due on the last day of class before Christmas Break.
 - a. Task 1: Write a short summary of what you view in the movie each day.
 - b. Task 2: From now until Christmas Break complete 3 significant "pay it forward" acts. (Acts of kindness, must be sincere, truthful, genuine, and affect someone's life for the better. Remind the people you are affecting to continue to "pay it forward".
 - c. Task 3: On the last day of class before Christmas Break, type the results of your "pay it forward" acts. Identify each act (names are not necessary) along with the outcome and reaction you received for your "pay it forward" act. (How did the person receiving the "pay it forward" react to your act, what did they say or do? How did this act and reaction make you feel? Did you remind them to "pay it forward"?)
